The Paris-based international architect and designer's signature style is a maximalist mash-up of colour, pattern, shape and texture. She's responsible for some of our favourite interiors in Paris – from Hôtel Thominieux, to Jean-François Piège's signature restaurant, or the café Germain – but in London too, with for example the exquisite overhaul of Sketch's main dining room The Gallery. India's elegant furniture and home accessories collections, the fruit of her interior design projects, are on show and sale in two separate boutiques that echo and complement each other.
